Which has resulted in many varied surgical procedures including abdominal, orthopedic, spinal and other complex surgery. My experience has also been strengthened with weekend, Bank Holiday and night shifts at Medivet's 24 hour hospital in Leamington Spa.

As a Student Veterinary Nurse at Pershore College, I have successfully completed my first year

passing two exams without needing to re-sit.

Throughout lockdown my current practice took the decision to furlough our Head Nurse and PCA, leaving myself and the vet to continue to provide a high level of care to our patients and clients. Despite the obvious challenges of car park consultations, we still managed to offer a high level of service with varied surgical procedures, home deliveries of medication to the elderly, vulnerable and shielded clients. We pulled together and continued to receive praise and thanks from happy owners as their pets recovered and felt their normal happy selves. My time as a solo nurse taught me a great deal about nursing and what I am capable of; nursing, theatre work, reception, general day to day duties of the practice such as admin and health and safety procedures which would normally be undertaken by the Head Nurse.

I have ridden since the age of six and enjoy working with ponies and horses. I have been a stable hand at the local Riding for the Disabled stables between the ages of 12 and 18; not only helping look after the ponies and horses, but also working with disabled children and adults so they can share my passion for riding and enjoy the benefits that riding brings to their health and more importantly their mobility too.
